106.07 Reports; certification and filing.—

(1) Each campaign treasurer designated by a candidate or political committee pursuant to s. 106.021 shall file regular reports of all contributions received, and all expenditures made, by or on behalf of such candidate or political committee. Except for the third calendar quarter immediately preceding a general election, reports must be filed on the 10th day following the end of each calendar quarter from the time the campaign treasurer is appointed, except that, if the 10th day following the end of a calendar quarter occurs on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the report must be filed on the next following day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday. Quarterly reports must include all contributions received and expenditures made during the calendar quarter which have not otherwise been reported pursuant to this section.

(b) Any other candidate or a political committee required to file reports with a filing officer other than the division must file reports on the **60th day immediately preceding the primary election, and biweekly on each Friday thereafter (i.e. 46th day, 32nd day, 25th day & 11th day) through and including the 4th day immediately preceding the general election.**

- 10/05/26** **Registration Books Close for the November 3rd Election** - 5 p.m. 29 days prior to election
- 10/09/26** **G4-26 CTR 25th day immediately preceding the General Election**
Covering September 26 – October 2, 2026
- 10/16/26** **Publication of Legal Notice for special election or referendum - 18 DAYS PRIOR TO ELECTION** F.S. 100.342 - - Once in the Third Week prior to the election
- 10/16/26** **G5-26 CTR 18th day immediately preceding the General Election**
Covering October 3 – October 9, 2026
- 10/20/26** **Precinct poll watcher designations** for Election Day must be submitted to the City (**PRIOR TO NOON** on the second Tuesday preceding the election). The City will fax all poll watcher designations to the SOE at 464-6239, and the Supervisor will verify whether they are registered to vote in Pinellas County.
- 10/23/26** **G6-26 CTR 11th day immediately preceding the General Election**
Covering October 10 – October 16, 2026
- ??-Pinellas County** **Publication of Sample Ballot and Polling Places - 11 days prior to election**
(City Code 26-36(d) **no more than 10 days prior to election**; and FS 101.20-at least 7 days prior to Election.)
- 10/30/26** **G7-26 CTR 4th day immediately preceding the General Election**
Covering October 17 – October 29, 2026
- 11/03/26** **Election Day**
- 02/01/27** **TRG-26 Termination Report** – Each candidate who withdraws his or her candidacy, becomes an unopposed, or is eliminated as a candidate or elected to office shall, within 90 days, dispose of campaign funds in the campaign account and file a Termination Report, pursuant to F.S.106.141(1)
