

Dunedin Marina Revocable Use Agreement Instructions and Application for Submittal

Dear Boat Owner:

Thank you for your interest in the Dunedin Marina. Please complete the following steps as outlined below.

- To complete the Marina Application for Slip Use, you will need the following information for the application:
 - ☐ Name, phone number, and address of vessel owner(s)
 - ☐ Boat specifications including make, type, year, beam, draft and overall length **Please note:** Overall length **includes bow pulpit, anchor, swim platform, dinghy, engine w/prop out of water, etc.** To occupy a slip, no part of the vessel shall be outside of the pilings when moored
 - ☐ Vessel Registration Number (FL) or Documentation Number (USCG)
 - ☐ Hull Identification Number (HIN)
 - ☐ Motor Model, Type, Year, Serial Number & HP (for each motor if multiple)
 - ☐ Fuel Type & Tank Size
 - ☐ Insurance Company, Address, Policy Number & Agent

The following documentation must also be submitted along with the completed application:

- ☐ Proof of Dunedin residency (must be Utility bill or lease if renting) for **EACH PERSON** on the Agreement (address cannot be a PO Box)
- ☐ Copy of driver's license
- ☐ Current Florida Vessel Registration or USCG Documentation
- ☐ Signed and **notarized** Human Trafficking Affidavit
- ☐ Signed Hurricane Vessel Action Plan
- ☐ Current Insurance Declarations Page must show adequate liability coverage in the amount of \$100,000 per occurrence and \$300,000 aggregate. The City of Dunedin must be listed as additional insured as follows:

- Upon receipt of all required documentation, the Harbormaster will prepare a Revocable Use Agreement to be signed by all applicants and then returned to the Harbormaster. Once approved by the City Manager, the applicant will be provided with a copy for their records.

Instructions: This form must be completed by an officer or representative of an entity entering into, renewing, or extending, a contract with the City of Dunedin.

The undersigned, on behalf of _____ ("Contractor"), hereby attests as follows:

- A.** Contractor understands and affirms that Section 787.06(13), Florida Statutes, prohibits the City of Dunedin from executing, renewing, or extending a contract to entities that use coercion for labor or services, with such terms defined as follows:
- **"Coercion"** means: **(1)** using or threatening to use physical force against any person; **(2)** restraining, isolating, or confining or threatening to restrain, isolate, or confine any person without lawful authority and against her or his will; **(3)** using lending or other credit methods to establish a debt by any person when labor or services are pledged as a security for the debt, if the value of the labor or services as reasonably assessed is not applied toward the liquidation of the debt, the length and nature of the labor or services are not respectively limited and defined; **(4)** destroying, concealing, removing, confiscating, withholding, or possessing any actual or purported passport, visa, or other immigration document, or any other actual or purported government identification document, of any person; **(5)** causing or threatening to cause financial harm to any person; **(6)** enticing or luring any person by fraud or deceit; or **(7)** providing a controlled substance as outlined in Schedule I or Schedule II of Section 893.03, Florida Statutes, to any person for the purpose of exploitation of that person.
 - **"Labor"** means work of economic or financial value.
 - **"Services"** means any act committed at the behest of, under the supervision of, or for the benefit of another. The term includes, but is not limited to, forced marriage, servitude, or the removal of organs.
- B.** Contractor hereby attests, under penalty of perjury, that Contractor does not use coercion for labor or services as defined in Section 787.06(2), Florida Statutes.

I, the undersigned, hereby represent that I make the above attestation based upon personal knowledge; am over the age of 18 years and otherwise competent to make the above attestation; and am authorized to legally bind and make the above attestation on behalf of Vendor. **Under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have read the forgoing document and that the facts stated in it are true.**
