May 18th-24th is National Safe Boating Week. We will have opportunities for boaters to participate in events being offered here at the Marina. - **Saturday, May 18th** - USCG Auxiliary will be onsite at the Dunedin Marina boat ramp to offer free vessel safety inspections to the public.
- **Saturday, May 18th & Sunday, May 19th** from 9am until 1pm - USCG Auxiliary is conducting a Boating Safety Course in the classroom of the Harbormaster's Office. - A thorough inspection of lines, chafing gear, etc. should be conducted. The Marina has fire hose available for those who would like to have some for chafing prevention.
- If you have a trailer, make sure it is ready for hauling should a storm threaten to our area.
- If you will not be available to secure your vessel during storm preparations, please provide the Marina office with the contact information of an alternate designee. Our limited staff will be busy securing the facility and will not be available to secure unattended vessels.
- Please remember to open all email communications from the Marina. If you change your email address, let us know so that we can update your file.
